Demonstrate safety and efficiency sailing a triangular course. Put the keelboat into a stable hove-to state. Reefing on and off mooring. Anchoring. Knots - R/turn + 2 half hitches / Bowline / Reef knot / Sheet bend / Clove hitch / Rolling hitch Carry out a single-handed man-overboard recovery. Lee shores -Carry out a mud grounding and recovery. Set, gybe and retrieve a spinnaker (Endorsement 6). Leaving, returning and pick-up mooring under full sail (if conditions allow) and again under jib only. Taking and letting go of a tow.
